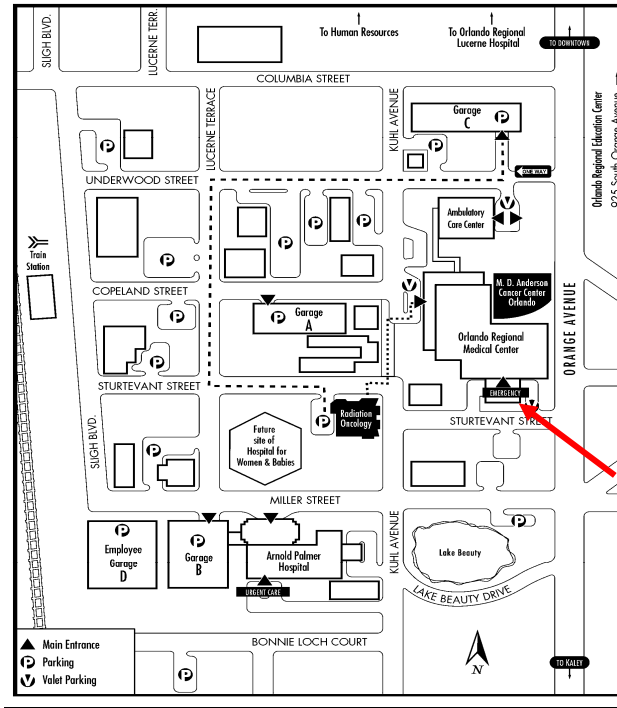
**The Florida Pain Initiative**
