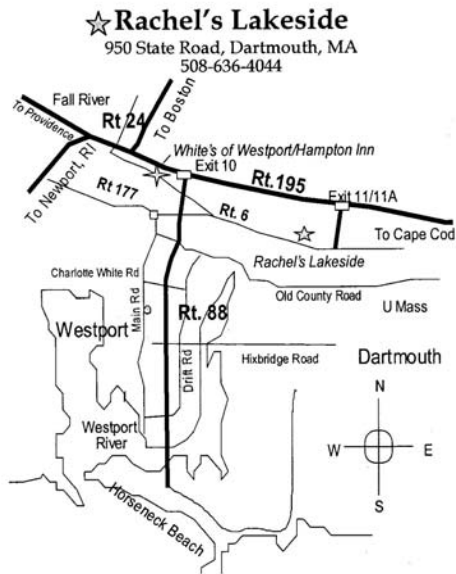
Directions to Rachel's Lakeside

from Boston and points north: (about 1 hour)
Route 93 South or Route 128 South to Route 24 South to Fall River, then 195 East to exit 11. Turn right onto Reed Road to Route 6. Turn right onto Route 6. Rachel's Lakeside is on the right.

from Providence: (about ½ hour) Route 195 east, to exit 11 ... proceed as above.

from Newport: (about ½ hour) 24 North to 195 east, to exit 11 ... proceed as above.

from Cape Cod and points east: (1/2 hour from Bourne bridge) Route 6 West to 25 North, which turns into 495 North. Then exit 2, 195 West, take Exit 11A. Turn right onto Reed Road to Route 6. Turn right onto Route 6. Rachel's is on the right side.
